CSO 1030 Sewer Separation Project

Description of Project: The Project includes the furnishing and installation of all labor, equipment, materials, appurtenances, and incidentals required for the construction of approximately 7,800 lineal feet of sanitary sewer pipe, 2,000 lineal feet of storm sewer pipe, 1,300 lineal feet of wateline, manholes, inlets, fire hydrants, butterfly valves, pavement restoration, and related site restorations.

The Bids will be publicly opened immediately thereafter and read aloud.

A voluntary prebid meeting is to be held on February 15, 2012 at 10:00 A.M. at the City of Newark Water Administration Office, 34 S. Fifth St., Newark, OH 43055.

The Contractor and all of his subcontractors shall be required to pay a rate or rates of wages which shall not be less than those currently determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services for Licking County, Ohio, and shall further comply with Chapter 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).

The Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Loan Funds (WPCLF) is providing funding for this project.

Each bid must contain the full name of every person or firm interested in the same and be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check, or letter of credit for 10% of the bid submitted in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 153.54; or a bond for the full amount of the bid submitted, as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its' performance properly secured. The bid security shall be forfeited if the said bidder fails to enter into a contract with City of Newark, and to furnish the required performance bond within fifteen (15) days after notice of acceptance of said bid. The amounts bid for labor and materials must be entered separately, on the forms provided upon application, and must be submitted in sealed envelopes plainly marked:

Should any bid be rejected, the accompanying bid bond, or check, will be returned to the bidder forthwith and should any bid be accepted, the check, or bid bond will be returned upon the proper execution and securing of the contract.

The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any or all bids.
