

Public Hearing

The City of Newark will conduct a public hearing Friday, August 9, 2019 at 2:00 PM in City Council Chamber, 1st floor, 40 West Main Street to discuss the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) draft for 2020-24. The AI is a local planning document that includes an analysis of fair housing issues and identification of significant housing needs and barriers to fair housing choice. The City is a Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Community that Affirmatively Furthers Fair Housing in accordance with federal regulations set forth by HUD and Civil Rights laws. As a result of the local analysis, goals to address barriers are to be outlined for the five year period, January 1, 2020-December 31, 2024. Community input is important.
