



It's time for the City of Newark's "Children's Letters to Santa" program for this Holiday Season.

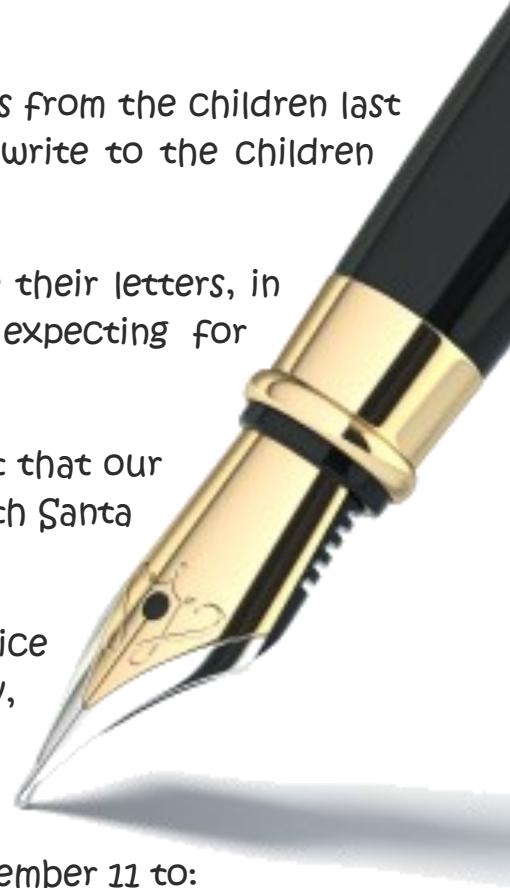
